- Upcoming financial obligations have all been met. The bonding fee has been paid. The 990 and IRS filings are complete. The internal audit is complete.
- Link Tyra went over the deposits and expenses in our unrestricted banking account from May 1, 2023 to August 31, 2023. Our unrestricted account has a \$14,543.35 balance.
- Link Tyra went over the deposits and expenses in our restricted bank account from May 1, 2023 to August 31, 2023. We have a \$30,740.49 balance in this account.
- The National mandate is that chapters digitize. Our Chapter is ahead of the curve as we are already using QuickBooks and PayPal.
