March 12, 2025 Chapter Meeting Minutes

Call to Order: Chapter President Link Kimberly Keaton Williams called the meeting to order at approximately 6:35 p.m. at the Detroit Golf Club.

Approval of Minutes: Approval of the February business meeting minutes. Motion made by Link Mearon Lewers and seconded by Link Judith McNeely. Motion passed by the body with no hesitancy or abstention.

Approval of Agenda: Approval of the agenda. Motion made by Link Portia Roberson and seconded by Link Denise Lewis. Motion passed by the body with no hesitancy or abstention.

President's Report: Link Kimberly Keaton Williams provided a written report and gave several updates during the meeting.

Link Kim started with a “thank you” to the host committee.

She also provided significant National Assembly updates. Madam President Ethel Isaac Williams hosted a town hall on Thursday, March 6, 2025, at the Westin Book Cadillac for the six Metro Detroit chapters. The chapter had about eleven people that rsvp'd. We had good attendance. Also, present was the national Link Marcia Page and national Protocol Chair Link Vonda Flentroy-Rice, national Chair of Events, Meetings and Assemblies, with Link Nicole Bernard, and then, Madame President's executive assistant Brianna Thacker, were in attendance. She thanked Link Leslie Farrow for preparing the beautiful courtesy baskets for our VIPs, which were well received.

As a reminder, twelve committees have been formed to support the 45th National Assembly, Link Kim thanked those chapter members who agreed to take on leadership roles. We have Connecting Link Committee Co-Chair Link Mearon Lewers, Entertainment Committee Chair



is Link Denise Brooks-Williams. Logistics Committee Chair is Link Michele Peterson. Registration Committee Co-Chair Link Casey Willis-Abner. We also have Link Tyra Evans serving as the treasurer for our six clusters for the 45th National Assembly. Link Tamira Chapman is chair for the Women's Empowerment Activities. Please reminder to sign up for the committees. Please go in and sign up because once March 31st comes if you have it signed up, we will help you sign up.

Madam President did confirm that we will have discounted registration, and it will count towards the "one-in-five" requirement. The community service activity will be Tuesday or Wednesday of the of the week of the National Assembly. Madam President is looking to do RFPs for some of the vendors, which she wants to support as many Black-owned businesses as possible. Sponsorship packages should be available by late summer.

In April, the local presidents will host a virtual meeting with twenty-four chairs and co-chairs to talk about next steps. On May 19th, Madam President is having a virtual all-hands meeting for the local presidents and twenty-four chairs and national leadership. The twelve committees will roll up to national leadership roles and there will be guidance from national leadership.

Madam President stated that she wanted all the planning completed by December 1, 2025.

Link Kim thanked Link Marlo Roebuck, Link Mearon Lewers, Link Michele Peterson, Link Markisha Williams, and Link Kristi Stepp for planning our Links getaway.

Please note that Central Area Conference is in Cleveland, Ohio. Early bird registration is available until March 31st, Link Kristi Stepp and Link Kimberly Keaton Williams will attend as chapter delegate and alternate. Note that one in five period just started over in 2024, and it will go through 2028. With the National Assembly in Detroit in 2026, everyone should be covered unless they do not plan attend.

We are looking at August 2nd for the Links Retreat since Madam President is planning to return on August 9, 2025, for another town hall. There may also be another chapter retreat in January 2026 to review and prepare for the national assembly.

Link Kim noted that the membership committee has set up a blind date dinner. There will be a Signup Genius for next Friday, March 21st at Seasons 52 and Summer Solstice will be June 20th.



Lastly, chapter dues in the amount of \$656 are due today. The \$100 national assembly assessment is due by April 15.

Vice-President's Report: Link Kristi Stepp was not in attendance but provided a written report.

Treasurer's Report: Link Tyra Evans was not in attendance but provided a written report.

Program Chair Report: Link Roshunda Price provided a written report but was not in attendance.

Link Sherri Pierce reported that Black Family Wellness Expo is on Saturday, March 15, 2025, from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. at the Northwest Activities Center. Volunteers are needed and can sign up via Signup Genius. There will be a volunteer zoom meeting tomorrow from 8-9:30 p.m. Everyone should plan to arrive by 8:30 a.m. on Saturday morning, March 15.

Link Christina Clark described the menopause panel discussion. Our very own Dr. Rose Moten and Dr. Jennifer Fuller will be speaking. Our facilitator will be Link Denise Brooks-Williams. The panel will be at 11-11:15 a.m. and it will be for 45 minutes. A Wegovy drug representative will be at the chapter's table. Link Christina wanted to thank everyone for putting up the all the zoom calls.

Link Chrystal Wilson reported for the Arts Facet, which will have an art therapy activity. She also reported that Black K.A.R.E. will have a community health fair "Don't Fool Around With Your Health" at Davis Aerospace/Golightly on Tuesday, April 1st from 3:30 to 6:30. This will be primarily for students, staff, and community members on the East side. There will be health screenings, dinner, cooking demos.

Link Shirley Mobley-Woods reported on the Services to Youth Facet activity. There was a four-woman panel to talk to 11th graders regarding potential careers. The panel included Link Melanie Harris and Link Portia Roberson. The panelists rotated between various tables. The students received a journal and blinged out ink pens.

Link Gail Perry Mason gave the International Trends Facet are having a "Cupcakes and Currency" on April 16, 2025, at 9 o'clock for the 12th grade students at Marygrove. Students will discuss current international trades, imports/exports, tariffs and economic trends. They will be putting a tariff on the cupcakes and the students will have to navigate the tariffs and currency to purchase the cupcakes.



Link Sherri Pierce mentioned that there is a challenge for get students their state identification cards and registered. Many students do not have access to their original birth certificates, so they have only been able to register about ten students with the Secretary of State mobile unit. The mobile unit will return the next week. The chapter will pay for the identification cards for twenty-five students.

Protocol Moment – Link Judy McNeely and Link Jenice Mithcell Ford provided the Protocol Pearls for January and February. The March Protocol Pearl was not yet received. Link Jenice went through the proper protocol for introducing National and Chapter Officers for plenary sessions, luncheons and other formal programs. Link Judy talking about the guidelines for use of Links, Inc. name and logo and chapter affiliations.

New Business: Link Michele Peterson reported that next Links Getaway is scheduled for October 25-30th, 2025 in Panama City, Panama. Link Gail Perry Mason will be recognized on March 15th. Link Denise Fair Razo received a shout out for representing the City of Detroit well as the Chief Public Health Officer.

Link Kim also recognized Link Melanie Harris and the recent reception in her honor as President of the Detroit Pistons. Link Portia Roberson was recognized for her recent election as the Vice Chair of the Michigan Democratic Party.

All of the Link sisters with March birthdays were recognized and celebrated.

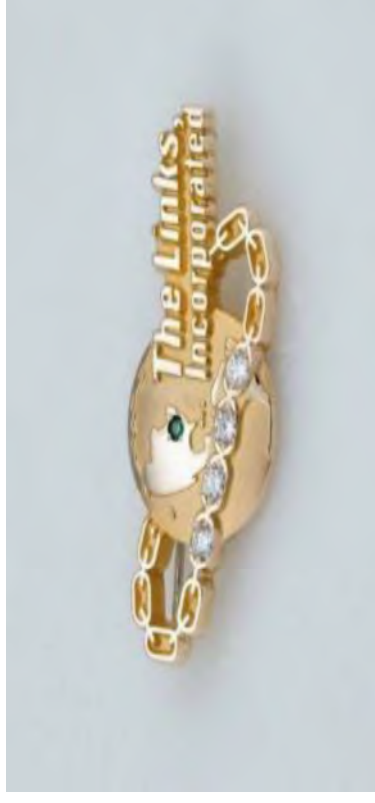
Uninterrupted white does NOT include:
